The CEO will perform fiscal and administrative management duties to actively lead BBBS to exceed strategic goals and increase the number of youth served within its market area.

- Responsible for developing and maintaining sound financial practices.
- Work with the staff, the committees, and the Board of Directors in preparing budgets.
- Hire, supervise and engage staff to meet organization objectives including, but not limited to:

 - Fundraising projects.
 - o Community partnerships and outreach presentations.
 - Developing programs and policies designed to increase matches.
 - Approve the program director's program service guidelines, case work manual, intake, matching and match closure procedures.
 - Assuring compliance with BBBSA national standards.
 - Establishing sound working relationships and cooperative arrangements with community groups and organizations.

- Partner with staff to conduct orientation/training of new hires, as needed.
- Conduct employee performance evaluations.
- Conduct staff meetings regularly.
- Assign/reassign job duties to maximize efficiency.
- Maintain official records and documents, and ensure compliance with federal, state, and local regulations.
- Maintain agency manual including personnel policies.
- Other duties as assigned by the Board of Directors.
